H. DISTRICT BUSINESS

- 1. Presentation by Dr. Marie Pinto, CEO ProYouth HEART (Information item)- Dr. Pinto announced that after 3 years of applying, Buena Vista was finally awarded the ASES grant. She requested a renewal of the contract based on the error in the attendance reporting to be approved in the short term and act as a placeholder until they can submit a new contract that will include the ASES grant funding. The intent to award is \$119,106 per year for 3 years. Mr. Brown asked for an explanation of the ASES grant. Dr. Pinto let him know the ASES grant us to be used for before and after school care for the 180 days that school is in session. Mr. Souza said the parents want the program. The ASES grant application was for 65 kids. Attendance will need to be 85% of 65 program participants= 55 kids. Attendance is taken quarterly to make sure we are meeting the requirements. Compliance is mandatory so it is important that the parents are educated about the program. The ratio of students is 20 to 1 for grades 1 thru 8 and 10 to 1 for TK & Kindergarten. This money could be used for academic tutoring and would be open to everyone. It could also be used to operate a 4H program. These are state funds and the money is protected. The federal funds have been cut and affected all the high schools. HEART will start counting attendance in January 2026.
